#### WHO WE ARE?

We set up solidarity-based organized trips for teenagers. Based on exchange and dialogues between cultures, each journey is a unique experience thanks our local partnerships. Our aims are clear and our actions focused.

#### THE CLEAR AIMS

In reaction to mass-tourism Ponts du Monde promotes an alternative way of traveling based on specific values such as solidarity, equity, and respect for the environment. Our organization has four main aims:



CREATE RESPONSIBLE YOUNG ADULTS (Sensible tourism). The educational aspect is essential to Ponts du Monde. Our aim is to educate future world citizens i.e. men and women responsible for their acts. Ponts du Monde thus encourages teenagers to adopt eco-friendly and socially-respectable practices and habits they will be able to continue and convey to others. Our organized trips give teenagers the opportunity to directly try out sustainable development; a theme they are already familiar with thanks to the media and school.



**INTEGRATE THE LOCAL POPULATION (Fair trade tourism).** Ponts du Monde offers a wide range of activities and socially and economically responsible services to the local populations. We participate in the associative life of local communities (lodging, local transportation, etc...) Also, host communities are involved in the management of these activities and benefits are equally shared among the members of the indigenous population.



**CONTRIBUTE TO THE PROTECTION OF LOCAL ENVIRONMENTS (Ecotourism).** Ponts du Monde offers environmental trips and through its numerous activities, it helps protect the local areas (the environment and the flora and the fauna in particular).



**FACILITATE THE ACCESS TO** underprivileged social groups (Social tourism). In collaboration with specialized associations Ponts du Monde seeks funding for teenagers who come from moderate-income backgrounds.

# **FOCUS AREAS:**

Pont du Monde collaborates with local associations for all their trips. Teenagers will actively be able to partake in local projects and assist the local communities. Ponts du Monde promises to give back 3% of its benefits to local associations with whom it collaborates. In most cases, it is a financial contribution. However, it can also help in other ways for instance by bearing costs related to specific needs of the local structures (e.g.: hiring professional photographers and other artists).
